

Fragrant Florange Wallflower



Erysimum 'Florange Orange'

- **Use:** Wallflowers gladden the heart in spring with their heady fragrance and rich colours - a reminder summer is not far away. This new variety is heat tolerant. Very floriferous, well-branched plants display brightly colored scented blooms in Spring to Autumn landscapes and mixed containers. Beautiful fragrance reminiscent of old English gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun-part shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-12" tall and wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-9; Perennial; Will reseed.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Small long green leaves.
- **Flower:** Clusters of clove-scented, orange flowers appear from spring to summer above the lance-shaped, dark green leaves. Fragrant blooms two times a year if cut back after flowering.
