

East Indian Holly Fern



Arachnoides simplicior 'Variegata'

- **Use:** Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. Outstanding SEMI-EVERGREEN plant that can be used as both a perennial plant or a colorful, indoor potted plant. It is a lovely, slow growing fern that is very popular with fern fanciers. The glossy green fronds have a very prominent yellow variegation, making it a choice accent plant in the landscape.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Height and width of 12-24 inches.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Distinctive, finely textured, scaly foliage has a showy, soft yellow streak down the middle. Fronds come up then spread softly horizontal.
- **Flower:** none



Semi-evergreen, shade-loving, and deer resistant
