Semi-evergreen, shade-loving, and deer resistant

Dryopteris erythrosora

- **Use:** Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part shade–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 18" to 24" tall and spreads slowly up to 15" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** This hardy fern is a native to Japan and sports a beautiful coppery – red color on lush green fronds, when mature the leaves will fade to green. In most areas it is evergreen. Very easy to grow and is a perfect foil for hostas in the woodland garden.
- **Flower:** none
