

Blue Peacock Fern



Selaginella uncinata

- **Use:** This creeping fern ally is spectacular as a ground cover in terrariums performing like a champ under low light. It's the low light which brings out the deep shimmering peacock blue. Peacock spikemoss forms a low growing mat which will root prolificly as it spreads. Looks great in rock gardens with bright metallic blue foliage in the summer and copper/bronze color in the fall.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial shade– shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN! Most striking color is achieved in acid earth
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 1 to 2 feet high; equal width in only 3–4 years.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers.
