

Gallo Red Blanket Flower



Gaillardia x grandiflora 'Gallo Red'

- **Use:** A blooming dynamo, the heat tolerant bright red flowers and burgundy button centers enhance the garden from summer well into fall. Hardy from one end of the country to the other, this native perennial is happy in any sun-soaked spot. It puts up with heat, humidity, cold, poor soil, and -- once it has built up a good root system in your garden -- drought. The flowers are lovely for cutting, too
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Flower stalks to only 12 in. tall, mounds to 18 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. The flowers top mounds of roughly textured gray-green leaves
- **Flower:** A blooming dynamo, the heat tolerant bright red flowers and burgundy button centers enhance the garden from summer well into fall.
