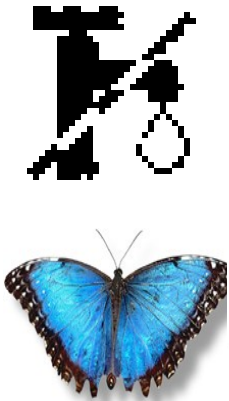


# Lunar Honeymoon Blanket Flower



## *Gaillardia x grandiflora* 'Lunar Honeymoon'

- **Use:** With its bright yellow ray flowers and deep yellow cone on a strong, mounding, tight habit, this was a top performer throughout the summer. In trials from south to north, from May to early September, it demonstrated excellent heat tolerance and no evidence of splitting. Thrives in sun and heat, nice touch in the rock garden or border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. It tolerates a very wide range of climates, including hot/humid, hot/dry and cool/moist (in well-drained soil).
- **Growth:** Flower stalks to only 10-12 in. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone 4-9;** Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. The flowers top mounds of roughly textured gray-green leaves
- **Flower:** Golden blossoms from spring until fall frosts. One of the top performing perennials for long lasting color in hot sun.
