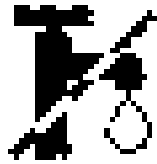


# Butterfly Whorl Gaura



## *Gaura lindheimeri* 'The Bride'

- **Use:** Once established it is very drought tolerant. Great for areas where you can't get the hose in the summer. Glowing, broad gold margins on the foliage, and white butterfly-like blooms similar to the species. A lovely addition to the garden. Superb in containers, borders, beds, and open woodland gardens. Deer resistant. Drought tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part sun, very easy to please. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 3.5' tall, 3 ft. wide, Cut back often for fullness.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8, perennial. Reseeds
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small green leaves with red speckles.
- **Flower:** Long slender stems bearing small pink/white flowers that look like butterflies! Long bloom season!

Lots of blooms for 5 months!
