

Colorado Gold Treasure Flower



Gazania linearis 'Colorado Gold'

- **Use:** Bright daisy-like blooms with deep russet center flecks dance just above compact mounds of glossy green leaves with silvery undersides. Tough, durable, and drought tolerant when established. Makes an easy-to-grow ground or slope cover. Perfect for rock gardens or at the front of a border. Evergreen in mild winter areas. Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun preferred. Once established, water occasionally; more in extreme heat or containers.
- **Growth:** Fast growing; reaches 3 to 6 in. tall, spreading to 1 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen; The foliage is attractive, too (though who can pay any attention to it, under those wild blooms?), with silvery-gray highlights. What a show!
- **Flower:** A long-blooming, cold hardy perennial that covers itself with bright-yellow daisy-type flowers. Reseeds readily. Deadhead to prevent reseeding, if desired.

Tips from the pros: A perfect plant for rock gardens, the front of beds or borders, in planters, massing or drifts, or in shortgrass meadows.
