Geranium sanguineum

- **Use:** These plants require minimal care once well established and are free from pests and diseases. Good for the rock garden, border or as a ground cover. Suitable for cut flowers. This perennial can be a very useful weed smothering, tight nit ground-cover.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part sun. Keep surface of soil moist, but not soggy.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 12-14" high and keeps spreading quickly to look mature overnight, but not invasive.
- **Hardiness:** 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Lovely cascading forest grass is chartreuse in the shade but more golden given more sun. Looks best against plants with black leaves.
- **Flower:** Masses of rich, deep magenta flowers throughout the season. Blooms midspring until fall. Pinch rather heavily after flowering to encourage blooming throughout the summer.
