

Super Blue Lilyturf



Liriope muscari 'Super Blue'

- **Use:** Showy spikes of deep purple flowers rise above the arching, dark green, grass-like foliage, followed by clusters of black ornamental berries. A superb groundcover, edging or border plant for partially shaded woodland areas. Excellent for use along rock-edged pools and waterfalls. Tolerates drier conditions when established.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 3 hours afternoon sun for good leaf coloring.
- **Growth:** Quickly forms foliage clump 20 in. tall and wide. Mow down with lawnmower to 3” tall in February for a clean look.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. It has dark green foliage.
- **Flower:** Fall, these flowers bloom in cone-shaped bunches at the end of tall green stems. Super Blue is noted for having showiest blooms of the Liriope family. From Summer to early As the autumn chill settles in, these flowers are replaced by glossy purple-black fruits.
