

Variegated Liriope



Liriope muscari 'Variegata'

- **Use:** Also known as Liriope variegated lily-turf, is as its name implies, a variegated border
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 3 hours afternoon sun for good leaf coloring.
- **Growth:** Grows 9 to 12" tall and spreads to 2-3 feet tall over 3 years. Excellent for edging and ground covers. When plantings space 12-15" apart at least for fast display. Mow down with lawnmower to 3" tall in February for a clean look.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The grassy foliage is edged with creamy yellow.
- **Flower:** It has purple-blue blooms, similar to grape hyacinths in summer.

Low maintenance.
