

Little Miss Dwarf Maiden Grass



Miscanthus sinensis 'Little Miss'

- **Use:** Arching blades emerge green, then turn red-purple, while center leaves stay green for striking bicolor effect. Reddish plumes mature to buff in late summer. Very neat clumping form.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. This plant tolerates some drought and occasional wetness. It prefers soil that is well-drained, loamy, sandy or clay with a pH preference of an acidic to slightly alkaline (6.8 - 7.7)
- **Growth:** Grows 24 - 36" tall, 18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Arching blades emerge green, then turn red-purple, while center leaves stay green for striking bicolor effect.
- **Flower:** Red flowers set showy buff-colored seed heads in late summer that hold through fall. An excellent compact grass for containers.

Finally, a more colorful grass for the colder climates and works in containers too!!
