Miscanthus sinensis 'Morning Light'

- **Use:** Clump forming plants with reed-like stems and leaves that are narrow and arch to the ground. The flower heads are puffy plumes that form in late summer to fall and make good cut or dried flowers. Great specimen or used in groups as a screen. We think they look graceful by our swimming pool in large containers!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Grows 4 to 5 feet tall, with flowers 5 to 6 feet tall.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Leaves have a narrow band of clear white on the leaf margins, causing them to appear silver from a distance.
- **Flower:** The flowers emerge a reddish-bronze color and dry to a fluffy cream.
