Finally, a more colorful grass for the colder climates and works in containers too!!

Miscanthus sinensis 'Purpurascens'

- **Use:** Spectacular fall color and cold hardiness make this Miscanthus stand out. Burgundy foliage and creamy white plumes remain long into winter. Picture-perfect with sunshine highlighting the silky plumes.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. This plant tolerates some drought and occasional wetness. It prefers soil that is well-drained, loamy, sandy or clay with a pH preference of an acidic to slightly alkaline (6.8 - 7.7)
- **Growth:** Grows 4-5' tall (5-6' in flower) and 2' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Foliage shows maroon wash turning reddish orange in fall - contrasting nicely with the feathery white plumes.
- **Flower:** Reddish-tinged flowers appear on tassel-like plumes above the foliage in late summer and in fall gradually become creamy white.
