- **Use:** Drought-prone gardens rejoice because 'Bandwidth' is here to save the day! This ornamental grass features lacy, eye catching multicolored foliage with an alternating yellow and green pattern that really stands out in traditional garden settings. As summer comes to a close, airy flower plumes emerge to add even more visual interest to this snazzy grass. This Miscanthus is compact with an attractive upright habit and is a real winner in borders, beds, and containers. Bandwidth is rust resistant, vigorous, and infertile so there's no need to worry about any errant reseeding. It is also resistant to both drought and deer so it is very low maintenance and stress free. Treat your thirsty landscape to the tenacious beauty of this petite and impressive maiden hair and take your foliage interest to the next level!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 2.5-3' feet in height and width. Compact enough to use in planters.
- **Hardiness:** **Zone** 5-9 Perennial /Grass Was bred to be infertile. The latter is a big plus for those concerned with reseeding.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Sports narrow foliage with green and gold bands. Foliage should be left standing throughout the winter for visual interest and to provide protection for the crowns. Cut foliage to the ground in early spring, just before new shoots appear.
- **Flower:** Topped by airy golden brown plumes in the fall, which persist into winter.
