

Black Mondo Grass



Ophiopogon planiscapus 'Nigrescens'

- **Use:** Infamous for its leathery, almost black evergreen foliage, well suited as a small scale ground cover. Fantastic against chartreuse plants. An attractive, tufted evergreen perennial groundcover with arching, grass-like foliage. Superior edging or border for partially shaded areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Needs at least 3 hours afternoon sun for good leaf coloring. Prefers moist, but not wet soils. Tolerates drier conditions when established.
- **Growth:** Slow spreading. Grows 4-8” tall. Mow down with lawnmower to 3” tall in February for a clean look.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The dark green grassy foliage.
- **Flower:** Pink tinged, white flowers followed by black berries.

Low maintenance and non-invasive.
