

Dwarf Fountian Grass



Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hameln'

- **Use:** Attractive grass highlighted by fluffy, buff-colored plumes arching above foliage. Terrific contrast when used among shrub or backdrop for perennial bed.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower mounding to 2 to 3 feet tall, 1 to 2 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Dark green tufted blades turn golden russet in fall.
