Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Hush Puppy'

- **Use:** Tasty! Long-lasting pink plumes spray high over rounded mounds of slender foliage. A long-flowering infertile selection that will not reseed. Another of the new sterile hybrids from the University of Georgia breeding program by Wayne Hanna.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 4 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower mounding to 3' tall(4' in plume) feet tall, 4 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Cut back grass to 1' tall in February to allow new growth to flush nicely.
- **Flower:** Produces a succession of new pink plumes from early July, and continuing to fall...an extended flowering season due to a lack of seed production.
