Low maintenance, deer resistant, and drought tolerant!

The gold foliage adds a pop of color!



Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Lumen Gold'

- **Use:** The bottlebrush plumes of Fountain Grass are always eye-catching. Now we have the foliage to match! This grass offers splendid, golden color and a rounded, compact habit. The foliage emerges bright gold in spring and softens to lemon in early summer. In our southeastern heat, it has transitioned to a light green by summer's end.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun or Partial shade. Old foliage should be cut to the ground in early spring. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth:** A compact habit and grows 12" wide and 1-1.5' tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9, Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Marvellous golden foliage in spring that turns lime green in summer. In a colder climate, more sun gives a more yellow foliage!
- **Flower:** Flowers are excellent for cutting, fresh or dried. Plants usually remain attractive well into the winter, the leaves turning shades of gold to orange then finally pale tan.
