Hedera helix 'Eva'

- **Use:** English ivy is grown primarily for its lush foliage, which forms a cool, green cover on walls or ground. It looks great in containers and hanging baskets or can be sheared and trained as topiary.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates a wide range of soils, but prefers rich loams. Easily grown in average, medium moisture, well-drained soils in part shade to full shade. Eva needs bright light to maintain the leaf variegation. As plants grow aurally, they develop bushier, more mature growth and develop sharper, triangular leaves with no lobes. Tolerates drought, best to let the soil dry out between watering.
- **Growth:** Mature height 6-12", spacing 12-18" wide. ***The saying goes- The 1st year it sleeps, the 2nd year it creeps, the 3rd year it leaps!*** Less invasive than straight green ivy we still recommend you contain it and do not let it loose in the landscape.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10, Perennial; Can also be grown as a houseplant.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Attractive, dark blue-green foliage marked with creamy white.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers
