

Bollene Lenten Rose



A must for color in the winter garden.

***Helleborus orientalis* 'Bollene'**

- **Use:** Beloved by shade gardeners everywhere for thick evergreen leaves and winter blossoms in the shade. Excellent in drifts in woodland gardens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Good drainage is a must.
- **Growth:** Grows 18" tall and wide; multiplies well.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen, virtually problem free. Older leaves can be cut back in late August to showcase winter blossoms better.
- **Flower:** Pretty, pendent or outward-facing, saucer-shaped, flowers from February to April. White with a light dusting of pink freckles.
