- **Use:** Flowering from late autumn to early spring. The well formed antique white flowers on strong stems are a joy to see during the cooler months. Use in the garden as a low growing perennial ground cover, as a patio table plant or as an indoor decoration in a cool position. The long lasting flowers and foliage of the Helleborus Gold Collection can even be used in cut flower arrangements. Makes a superb groundcover and choice perennial for shady borders.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Good drainage is a must.
- **Growth:** Grows 15-18 in. tall and 24 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; silver veined foliage, virtually problem free. Older leaves can be cut back in late August to showcase winter blossoms better.
- **Flower:** Pink buds open to large, creamy white flowers with shades of rose and cinnamon. Color is affected by temperature and flower age, resulting in multiple hues. Flowering from late autumn to early spring. The well formed antique white flowers on strong stems are a joy to see during the cooler months.
