

# Black Beauty Premium Coral Bells



## *Heuchera 'Black Beauty'*

**Glossy, ruffled dark purple foliage grows into a tight mound, providing excellent contrast for its sprays of tiny white flowers and for variegated, silver and golden foliage.**

- **Use:** Coral bells are easy to grow and blend easily with most other perennials in the landscape. Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 14 "tall, 24" in bloom overall, by 12-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Almost black leaves are a gorgeous accent to other foliage.
- **Flower:** Cream-colored, bell-shaped blooms rise above height given: up to 16" in the summer.
