

# Heuchera Carnival Fall Festival



## *Heuchera 'Carnival Fall Festival'*

- **Use:** Coral Bells are a versatile perennial. This villosa hybrid, part of the Carnival series, known for their tidy mounding habit and excellent heat and humidity tolerance, is a terrific choice for adding a touch of colour towards the front of a border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. More sun tolerant than other coral bells. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 10-12 “tall, 12-14” wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Deeply lobed, green leaves have a heavy silver overlay and burgundy undersides.
- **Flower:** Dainty white flowers are held aloft on airy stems May through July.

Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.
