## ***Heuchera 'Fire Alarm'***

- **Use:** Fiery, red hot foliage in early spring and fall. Spikes of pink, bell-shaped flowers shimmy above reddish stems in summer. A superb companion with seasonal garden color. Provides bold texture and color contrast in mixed containers or borders in bright or dappled shade. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Clumping foliage 8 to 10 in. tall, 12 to 16 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Bright red in spring and fall and darkens to a brown-red during the summer. This hybrid of *H. villosa* has thick, leathery red, red leaves that make delightful medium size mound.
- **Flower:** Palest pink flowers attract hummingbirds with their nectar.
