This smaller type of coral bells is excellent for container gardening and is the most intense red we have seen!



Heuchera 'Forever Red'

- **Use:** This lovely, fast growing Heuchera has the reddest leaves ever, a great crown, and it is a vigorous grower. The leaves are cut and somewhat ruffled and reddest in the spring and fall when the temperatures are cooler.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Clumping foliage 7-14 in. tall, 14 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. The reddest foliage to be found, with intensely colored, incised, lightly ruffled leaves on deep red stems. Foliage color is most intense in the cooler spring and fall months.
- **Flower:** The 14" spikes with white flowers in mid summer complement and contrast with the foliage.
