

Southern Comfort Premium Coral Bells



Heuchera 'Southern Comfort'

- **Use:** Huge cinnamon-peach leaves mature to burnished copper, then to amber and form a broad, lush clump, making a bold landscape statement. Thrives in hot, humid environments where others don't.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 12-15 "tall, 20" in bloom overall, by 20" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Extra large cinnamon-peach leaves mature to copper in the fall, making a warm color statement all year
- **Flower:** Spikes of creamy white flowers appear in summer. Delightful!



Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.
