Heuchera 'Vienna'

- **Use:** A bastion of artful traits; compact plants that produce a multitude of rose pink flowers on tight spikes. The plant continues to rebloom over veiled, multitoned, orange red leaves. This plant can be a centerpiece in a small pot, or can offer a supporting role in the landscape. Provides bold texture and color contrast in mixed containers or borders in bright or dappled shade. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Clumping foliage 7-12 in. tall, 22 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Amber orange, deep rose and honeydew green foliage are accented with bold veining to create interesting patterns. Leaves are softly highlighted with a touch of shimmering silver.
- **Flower:** Extremely long-blooming tight spikes of showy rose-pink bells complete this masterpiece.
