

# Splendens Coral Bells



## *Heuchera sanguinea* 'Splendens'

**It makes a good choice for attracting hummingbirds to your yard, and it is a relatively low maintenance perennial.**

- **Use:** This coral bell is excellent when mixed into ornamental containers on shady patios, so enjoy the color and texture of this dense, mounded, herbaceous evergreen perennial all year round! The basal foliage is heart shaped or roundish with 5-7 slightly toothed lobes. Its crinkled lobed leaves remain dark green in color throughout the year. The unique-looking flowers of 'Splendens' coral bells are wonderful for a border.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 12-18 "tall, 24" in bloom overall, by 12-18" wide. Should be cut back in late fall in preparation for winter
- **Hardiness:** 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. The foliage is dark green, and geranium-like.
- **Flower:** Produces vivid, scarlet flowers that bloom in late spring-early summer.
