

Hibiscus Luna Red



Attracts hummingbirds!
Fast-Growing and has Big Blooms!

***Hibiscus moscheutos* 'Luna Red'**

- **Use:** A vigorous, sturdy, rounded, somewhat shrubby, woody-based hibiscus (or rose mallow) cultivar. It features dinner plate-sized, five-petaled, hollyhock-like flowers (7-8" diameter).
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Prefers to be watered under the leaves.
- **Growth:** Full, well branched plants grow QUICKLY to 2-5' tall and wide in one season.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 Perennial. Very heat tolerant!
- **Foliage:** Deciduous
- **Flower:** Flowers are a red. Each flower has a prominent and showy red central staminal column. Individual flowers last only one day, but they are always plenty ready to open.
