

# Hosta 'American Halo'



A large growing type that is very easy to grow!

## *Hosta 'American Halo'*

- **Use:** Very large with time. A sport of H. 'Northern Halo.' Large, pucker leaves make this plant a favorite of many gardeners.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)—shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Mature height of 22" tall and 60" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large creamy white edge with dark blue-green center.
- **Flower:** In early summer, dainty white flowers will blend in well with all the plants in your garden.
