Hosta 'Christmas Tree' (Hosta 'Frances Williams' x Hosta 'Beatrice')

- **Use:** Hosta are among the most popular of perennials for shady areas, with hundreds of varieties now readily available. Plants form a sturdy mound of foliage, topped with lily-like blooms. Christmas Tree boasts large, heavily textured leaves with a yellow turning to creamy-white edge create a showy plant for shady borders and woodland gardens. Resists slug damage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 23 inches tall by 56 inches wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Produces dark green leaves with a thin yellow margin that fades to creamy white in the summer, and occasionally streaks to the center of the leaf. Forms an attractive mound of rounded leaves that are cupped and heavily corrugated.
- **Flower:** Lavender flowers in mid summer are followed by stunning reddish purple seed pods.
