

Hosta 'City Lights'



**Shade loving and very
easy to grow!**

Hosta 'City Lights' (Hosta 'White Vision' and Hosta 'Golden Prayers' hybrid)

- **Use:** The leaves are very large measuring 12" long by 9" wide, cupped, heavily corrugated and thick. Near white flowers on 32" scapes early summer. Big golden hosta specimen for a stunning back drop. Known for its excellent bright yellow color, thick leaves and large mound size. It is a fairly good grower that holds up well through the season.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 27" to tall and spreads up to 48" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Rounded leaves are slightly cupped, thick and heavily corrugated, chartreuse changing to bright yellow as the season progresses, coloring best in some bright light.
- **Flower:** Pale lavender to near white flowers bloom in early to mid-summer.
