Hosta 'Dream Queen'

- **Use:** Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. Probably the most exciting new hosta to hit the market in years. A sport of H. 'Great Expectations' which is very similar to H. 'Thunderbolt'. Heavy substance, slug resistant and sun tolerant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun(with excellent soil and watering) part sun (best)—shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Vigorous growing clump, to 24" wide and 24" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large, nearly round, corrugated leaves are bluish-green with a narrow, creamy white center
- **Flower:**
- White flowers are produced on 26 inch scapes in midsummer
