Hosta 'Earth Angel'

- **Use:** Now, one of the great hostas has been made even better. A marvelous creamy-edged (yellow in spring) mutation of Hosta 'Blue Angel'. This breakthrough is the first giant blue hosta to have a border ... stand up and cheer! A must for the collector.

Exposure/Soil: Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.

- **Growth:** Grows 3' tall and 5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Thick, wide, pointed, blue leaves, each surrounded by a 1" wide, creamy border (yellow in spring).
- **Flower:** In midsummer, lavender flowers appear on 20in scapes.
