Named Hosta of the Year for 2010 by the American Hosta Growers Association, 'First Frost' comes highly recommended.

Hosta 'First Frost'

- **Use:** This medium-size Hosta spreads to 3' wide and has blue leaves with good substance and creamy yellow borders that age to white in partial shade. This sport of 'Halcyon' keeps its good looks all season.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 16" to tall(28" in bloom) and spreads up to 24-30" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. prized for its robust foliage which remains attractive straight through to the first frost! Rich blue-green leaves have a creamy yellow border that gradually fades to white. Thick leaves resists slug damage.
- **Flower:** The light lavender flowers appear in midsummer on 24" stalks.
