Hosta 'Fragrant Bouquet'

- **Use:** Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. Excellent for use in containers as well! They are one of the strongest plants you can plant in the shade! Noted for its vigor and fragrance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Medium 20" (3' in bloom) - plant 18" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Apple green leaves with a creamy edge.
- **Flower:** This hosta blooms with incredible fragrance in August. Blush lavender buds open to white and quite large flowers - often 3-4" across.
