

Hadspen Blue Hosta



Shade loving and very easy to grow! An excellent cut flower. Looks great with Ghost Painted Fern and white Bleeding Heart!



Hosta 'Hadspen Blue'

- **Use:** Forming neat clumps of heart-shaped, grayish blue leaves about 5" long, 'Hadspen Blue' is a smaller Hosta variety and one of our favorite edging plants for paths through shady gardens. A perfect backdrop plant to fill in the shade garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Vigorous growing clump, to 20-26" high and 18-24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Steel blue-gray leaves have a soft powdery look and create an elegant mound of foliage.
- **Flower:** In late summer, pale mauve blooms appear on 14" stems.
