A fragrant type that is very easy to grow!

Hosta 'Hoosier Harmony'

- **Use:** This exciting 1995 introduction is already becoming an industry standard. This sport of the ever-popular H. 'Royal Standard' features chartreuse foliage with contrasting green edges. Each 3' wide clump features a midsummer show of 3' tall stalks of fragrant white flowers...a showstopper!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Mature height of 24 inches tall by 36 inches wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The leaves have a chartreuse to gold center surrounded by an irregular dark green margin.
- **Flower:** Large, fragrant, white flowers from July to August on 3' tall scapes.
