

Hosta 'Hush Puppie'



This miniature hosta has small, rounded, green leaves edged with wide, creamy yellow borders. Plants rapidly form 16" wide clumps.

Hosta 'Hush Puppie'

- **Use:** This hosta is small in size but not in vigor. Small twisted leaves are dark green with a wide cream edge.
- The vigorous growth rate and small habit make this hosta perfect as a border plant. Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. Excellent for use in containers as well! They are one of the strongest plants you can plant in the shade!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 7 inches tall by 16 inches wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Apple green leaves with a creamy edge.
- **Flower:** Dark lavender flowers in summer.
