Hosta 'June

- <u>Use:</u> Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. From England comes this wildly popular, creamy-centered sport of the old standard H. 'Halcyon'. . This is one of those shockingly beautiful hostas that stand out as soon as you spot it in the garden. We recommend some morning sun for best coloration.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Part sun (best)—shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** The 3' wide clumps grow quickly to 18" tall.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 5-8 Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Each leaf emerges with blue edges and a brilliant creamy center that gradually changes to dark chartreuse.
- *Flower:* Light violet flowers on 20" scapes in early summer.
