A large growing type that is very easy to grow!

Hosta 'Robert Frost'

- **Use:** A breathtaking in spring when the frosty blue-green leaves are bordered by a nice yellow margin. Forms a large mound of large leafed contrasting colors, use in the background, a beautiful specimen!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Mature height of 24 inches tall by 50 inches wide
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Heart-shaped blue-green leaves with creamy-white margins adorn this beautiful mounding hosta. By late summer the mound is green with a streaky white margin.
- **Flower:** Pale lavender flowers from July to August on 3' tall scapes.
