

# Hosta 'Victory'

## ***Hosta 'Victory'***

- **Use:** **American Hosta Growers Hosta of the Year 2015** This sport of 'Elatior' has shiny green leaves with wide cream margins. Large heart-shaped leaves have a wavy cream margin. These very large thick leaves are held upright as they emerge and form a massive mound when mature. Absolutely stunning hosta that should be used as a specimen plant where it can be appreciated! Slug resistant thick leaves.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 36" to tall and spreads up to 7' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. It has smooth and shiny green leaves that start out with about ½ inch wide yellow-chartreuse margins that fade to pale yellow or cream over the course of the season. The heart-shaped leaves are up to a foot long with wavy margins and prominent veins that produce a corrugated look. Although it is vigorous, with a slow to medium growth rate, like many large hostas, 'Victory' takes some years to develop the huge leaves and distinctive variegation characteristic of the cultivar.
- **Flower:** White- lavender flowers appear on very tall scapes (maybe 7' tall).
