Hypericum densiflorum 'Creel's Gold'

- **Use:** Creel's Gold Hypericum produces loads of 1" golden yellow flowers set against deep green narrow foliage on semi-upright to arching stems in midsummer. This is an easy to grow small evergreen to semi-evergreen shrub. Excellent for extreme slopes or sandy soils; spreads by underground stems; moderate drought tolerance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-sun is best, although plants will adapt to partial shade. Too much irrigation or wet soils is not a good thing. A light trimming with the clippers in late winter (February) will encourage new growth in spring.
- **Growth:** Rapid growth to 12 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Emerges chartreuse-bronzed, but quickly turns to medium green then dark green, with fall color being a deep blue-green
- **Flowers:** Bright canary yellow flowers that contrast with the dark green foliage all season long. Each flower lasts one to two weeks. Followed by reddish fruits.
