

Evergreen Candytuft



Iberis sempervirens 'Purity'

- **Use:** Compact, evergreen, and very heavy-blooming, this perennial Candytuft is a pleasure in any sunny to lightly shaded setting. It flowers abundantly in early to mid-spring, forming a carpet of snowy color that makes the perfect backdrop to bulbs, chokes out weeds, and welcomes spring to the garden. A floriferous selection for borders, rock gardens or for use as a groundcover.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-10" tall and 1-2' wide or more. The flowers should be sheared off after blooming ceases, and old plants can be cut back to 4 in early spring after bloom.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Evergreen;
- **Flower:** Its low-growing, mounding habit complements the small, white, four-petal flowers that appear prolifically each spring. This is one of the largest flowering types of Candytuft.
