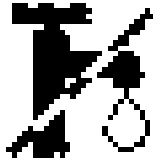


# Fireworks Lantana



## *Lantana 'Fireworks'*

- **Use:** Lantana are very heat tolerant. It is a tropical appearing shrub, but hardy! Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies. They also thrive in our dry summers. Lantana is a great option for the flower bed of your choice. It is a very heat and drought tolerant plant, which needs no dead-heading.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 10-15" tall, to 15-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-11, Tender perennial. **Do not cut back stems until April.** Water in the hollow stems will freeze out the roots in winter. Mulch with 2" of bark or pine straw around the plant.
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** With masses of flower clusters in vibrant red and vivid yellow, this plant just seems to sizzle and pop with color. Blossoms from April until frost.

**Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season; low maintenance.**
