Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season; low maintenance.





Lantana 'Fran's Red'

- <u>Use:</u> Plant characteristics are similar to other Lantanas. Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun.
- Growth: Mounded form to 1-2 feet tall, to 2-3 feet wide.
- <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 7b-11, Tender perennial. <u>Do not cut</u>
 <u>back stems until April.</u> Water in the hollow stems will
 freeze out the roots in winter. Mulch heavily around the
 plant, and plants must have good drainage.
- *Foliage:* Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
 - <u>Flower:</u> Has a great show of flowers that last from spring till frost, the flowers are golden yellow, orange and mostly red and will all deepen to red with age.
