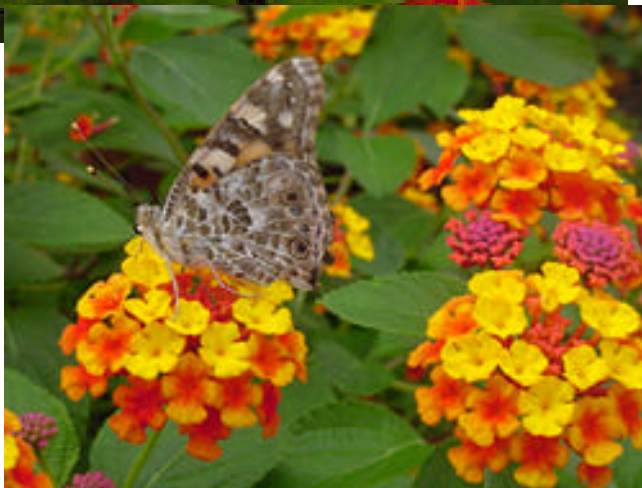
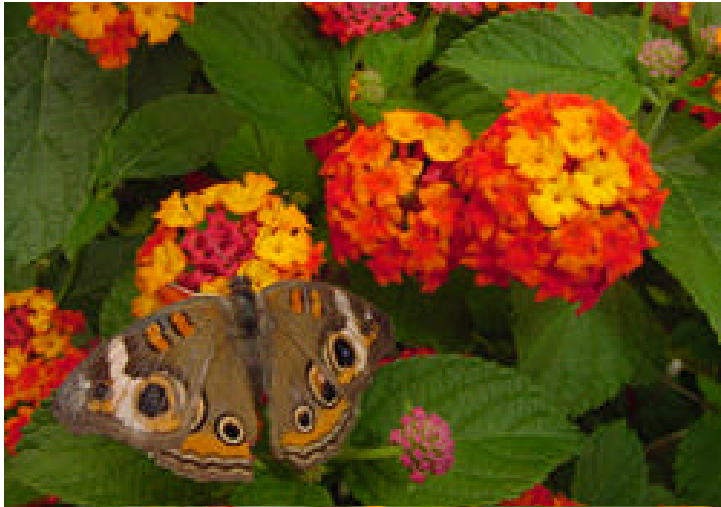


Radiation Lantana



Lantana camara 'Radiation'

- **Use**: Profuse color year-round from rich orange-red flowers! Useful as substitute for annuals in flower beds or containers. Excellent low hedge or accent shrub. Attracts butterflies. Tolerates heat.
- **Exposure/Soil**: Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth**: Mounded form to 3 to 5 feet tall, to 6 feet wide.
- **Hardiness**: 7-11, Perennial. Do not cut back stems until April after winter is passed.
- **Foliage**: Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower**: Showy clusters of red, yellow, and orange flowers through the season.

Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season; low maintenance. Has won numerous awards for plant vigor!
