

# Red Butler Lantana Basket



## *Lantana 'Red Butler'*

- **Use:** Tropical appearing shrub, but hardy! Plant characteristics are similar to other Lantanas. Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies. Deer and rabbit resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun.
- **Growth:** Mounded form to 3-4 feet tall, to 3-4 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 8-11, Tender perennial. **Do not cut back stems until April.** Water in the hollow stems will freeze out the roots in winter. Mulch heavily around the plant
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Red Butler produces large nearly 2" wide clusters of almost pure glowing red flowers from spring to frost on an upright growing Lantana. Its dark nearly solid red flowers and large clusters on a vigorous and free flowering plant make this an improvement over its parent Dallas Red. Like all Lantana, Red Butler attracts loads of pollinators throughout the growing season.



Heat and sun tolerant; flowers all season;  
low maintenance.
