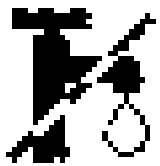


Carlos Lantana



Lantana camara 'Carlos'

- **Use:** Tropical appearing shrub, but hardy! Plant characteristics are similar to other Lantanas. Fine for mass plantings and banks, or containers for poolside...attracts butterflies.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun– part sun. Drought tolerant once established. Needs at least 6 hours afternoon sun. Must have good drainage in winter so please amend your red clay for best results.
- **Growth:** Shrub-type Lantana that can get 1-2' in height with a 2-3' spread.
- **Hardiness:** 7b-11, Tender perennial. **Do not cut back stems until following April.** Water in the hollow stems will freeze out the roots in winter. Mulch heavily around the plant with pine bark, etc.
- **Foliage:** Scented leaves. Deciduous. Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** The blooms are hot pink with a few yellow blossoms intermixed. Blooms from late spring until fall.
